

Data Set: Canadian Election Study, 2011, Attitude Towards Abortion

Source: Extract from data set distributed by the Institute for Social Research, York University

Variables:

- id Household ID number.
- province Province code (NL, PE, NS, NB, QC, ON, MB, SK, AB, BC); provinces were used as strata in the sampling design.
- population Population of the respondent's province, number over age 17.
- weight Weight sample to size of population, taking into account unequal sampling probabilities by province and household size.
- gender Female or Male.
- abortion Should abortion be banned? No or Yes.
- importance In your life, would you say that religion is very important, somewhat important, not very important, or not important at all? very, somewhat, notvery, or not.
- education Respondent's level of education: lessHS, HS, somePS, college, bachelors, or higher.
- urban Place of residence: urban or rural.
