Variables:

lfp: labor-force participation, no; yes.

k5: number of children 5 years old or younger.

k618: number of children 6 to 18 years old.

age: in years.

wc: wife's college attendance, no; yes.

hc: husband's college attendance, no; yes.

lwg: log expected wage rate; for women in the labor force, the actual wage rate; for women not in the labor force, an imputed value based on the regression of $\ln w$ on the other variables.

inc: family income exclusive of wife's income.
